Torah Portion:

Exodus 12:1-3

1 Now the L-RD spoke to Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, saying,

2 “This month shall be your beginning of months; it shall be the first month of the year to you.

3 Speak to all the congregation of Israel, saying: ‘On the tenth of this month every man shall take for himself a lamb, according to the house of his father, a lamb for a household.

Exodus 12:6-7

6 Now you shall keep it until the fourteenth day of the same month. Then the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it at twilight.

7 And they shall take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and on the lintel of the houses where they eat it.

Exodus 12:12-13

12 ‘For I will pass through the land of Egypt on that night, and will strike all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the L-RD.

13 Now the blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you are. And when I see the blood, I will pass over you; and the plague shall not be on you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt.

Matthew 26:17

17 Now on the first day of the Feast of the Unleavened Bread the disciples came to Yeshua, saying to Him, “Where do You want us to prepare for You to eat the Passover?”

Matthew 26:26 – 28

26 And as they were eating, Yeshua took bread, blessed[a] and broke it, and gave it to the disciples and said, “Take, eat; this is My body.”

27 Then He took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, “Drink from it, all of you.

28 For this is My blood of the new covenant, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.

Service Portion:

Matthew 24:3–8

3 Now as He sat on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to Him privately, saying, “Tell us, when will these things be? And what will be the sign of Your coming, and of the end of the age?”

4 And Yeshua answered and said to them: “Take heed that no one deceives you.

5 For many will come in My name, saying, ‘I am the Messiah,’ and will deceive many.

6 And you will hear of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not troubled; for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet.

7 For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. And there will be famines, pestilences, and earthquakes in various places.

8 All these are the beginning of sorrows.

Luke 21:25- 26

25 “And there will be signs in the sun, in the moon, and in the stars; and on the earth distress of nations, with perplexity, the sea and the waves roaring;

26 men’s hearts failing them from fear and the expectation of those things which are coming on the earth, for the powers of the heavens will be shaken.

Luke 21:28

28 Now when these things begin to happen, look up and lift up your heads, because your redemption draws near.”

1) THEN THERE WILL BE TRIBULATION (Matthew 24:9)

9 “Then they will deliver you up to tribulation and kill you, and you will be hated by all nations for My name’s sake.

2) THEN MANY WILL BE OFFENDED (Matthew 24:10)

10 And then many will be offended, will betray one another, and will hate one another.

3) THEN THE LOVE OF MANY WILL GROW COLD (Matthew 24:11-13)

11 Then many false prophets will rise up and deceive many.

12 And because lawlessness will abound, the love of many will grow cold. 13 But he who endures to the end shall be saved.

4) THE GOSPEL WILL BE UNSTOPPABLE (RELENTLESS) (Matthew 24:14)

14 And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come.
