2. How did they wait?

Acts 1:14, 4:31; Luke 3:21–22

- Acts 7:55–60** | Stephen prayed as he was being stoned.
- Acts 8:14–17** | Peter prayed for the Samaritans to receive the Holy Spirit.
- Acts 9:11** | Saul of Tarsus prayed after his conversion.
- Acts 9:36–43** | Peter prayed before he raised Dorcas from the dead.
- Acts 10:1–4** | Cornelius prayed that God would show him how to be saved.
- Acts 10:9** | Peter prayed and God told him to answer Cornelius’s prayers.
- Acts 12:1–11** | The believers prayed for Peter when he was in prison.
- Acts 13:1–3** | They fasted and prayed before sending out Barnabas and Paul.
- Acts 16:13–14** | They were praying, and God opened Lydia’s heart.
- Acts 16:16–18** | On the way to prayer, Paul cast a demon out of a girl.
- Acts 16:25** | Paul and Silas were praying, and God opened the prison doors.
- Acts 20:36; 21:5** | Paul prayed for his friends before leaving them.
- Acts 27:35** | During a storm, Paul prayed for God’s blessing.
- Acts 28:8** | After the storm, he prayed that God would heal a sick man.
