



**Focus** Each of us has a unique call on our lives and a specific assignment we were created by God to fulfill.

**Open** Did you have a favorite superhero as a child or someone you greatly admired?

**Read** In Psalm 139:13–16, it says, “For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother’s womb. I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well. My frame was not hidden from you when I was made in the secret place. When I was woven together in the depths of the earth, your eyes saw my unformed body.” In Ephesians 2:10, the Apostle Paul writes: “For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.”

We are all created by God with unique gifts and talents and with a unique purpose to fulfill.

- Talk**
1. Do you think our culture is captivated by the idea of superheroes? Why or why not?
  2. Did having a favorite superhero or person you admired as a child affect the way you acted or behaved? If yes, how? What was it about that superhero or person you admired the most or wanted to emulate?
  3. Job 10:8 says, “Your hands have made me and fashioned me [formed and shaped me].” Do you believe you were created by God and called for His purposes? If yes, why?
  4. Is it important that we believe we are unique and called of God? Why or why not?

5. Do you know what your unique talents are and how God has called you to use them? If you're comfortable, share with the group a talent or talents you feel God has given you. How do you feel God wants to use these talents to point people to Jesus?
6. Do you feel you're presently walking in or doing what God has created you to do? Why or why not? If not, do you feel you have somehow disqualified yourself from God's calling or purposes? If yes, then read 1 John 1:9. It says, "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."

### **Live**

1. What are some specific ways we can discover and develop our unique gifts and talents? How can you practically use these gifts and talents to point people to Jesus? If you're comfortable, share an example.
2. In what area(s) do you presently feel God is calling you to use your unique talents? Are there any areas you are currently wrestling with about why God made you the way He did? If you feel comfortable, share with the group. Then choose to commit everything about who you are, both your strengths and weaknesses, to the Lord, and from this day forward, walk in confidence of how God made you.

### **Pray**

Take a moment to quiet your heart before God. Ask Him what the talents and gifts are He has given to you, and how He wants to use you to point people to Jesus. If you need to, ask God to forgive you for anything you may have allowed to hinder you from walking in the fullness of what He has created and called you to do.

Thank You, Lord, that You have formed and fashioned us with unique talents and gifts. Thank You for calling us to Your purposes. I pray we would each know Your love in a greater way and would boldly walk in all You have called us to walk in. Help us to always seek to bring You glory and point others to You. I pray we would be consumed with a greater passion for You and a greater revelation of Your love for us and for others.
