1. Why is it important for a believer to understand God's omnipotence (limitless power), omniscience (infinite knowledge) and omnipresence (fully present everywhere)? How would you live differently if you didn't believe each of these characteristics of God were true?
 2. Why does God's omnipotence mean that we can overcome sin, sickness and Satan? (Read 1 John 4:4, if necessary.) Practically, how do we walk in God's power day to day?
 3. How does it make you feel to understand there is nothing about you that God doesn't already know, and nothing will ever catch God by surprise?
 4. Omnipresent means that God is fully present in all places at all times, yet we can sometimes feel that He is far away. What causes us to feel far away from God? What do we need to do to resolve these causes of separation?
 5. Have you experienced God's presence in a meaningful way? What difference did that experience have on your journey with God?

Live

1. What situation(s) are you facing in which you find it difficult to remember or rely upon God's omnipotence, omniscience or omnipresence?
2. What specific truth about God's character do you need to keep at the forefront of your mind relating to the situation(s) you're facing?
3. If you have a sense that God has been "far away" lately, take a moment to ask the Lord the reason why. Write down what comes to mind.

Pray for one another, asking God to make His power, wisdom and presence evident, especially in the difficult situation(s) each of you identified. Pray about any sense and cause of separation from His presence. Ask Him to empower and teach you every day.
