- Focus** The Holy Spirit came to fulfill Pentecost, and the Father has promised your very own Pentecost experience.
- Open** When best friends hang out, they have fun. What are some fun times you've had with the Holy Spirit this week?
- Talk**
1. What does the word "Pentecostal" mean to you? Discuss any life experiences you've had that either broadened or narrowed your view of Pentecost.
  2. Read Acts 2:1–4 and Leviticus 23:15–16. How does the Old Testament celebration connect with the New Testament fulfillment of the Day of Pentecost?
  3. Read Acts 2:5–11. Describe how the story of the Tower of Babel is related to the Day of Pentecost? Take a minute to explain the heart motivation behind these two events in history and their differences.
  4. When Jesus died on the cross, He totally fulfilled Passover. How is the arrival of the Holy Spirit on the Day of Pentecost similar to Jesus' Passover fulfillment?
  5. Read Acts 2:3–4 and Acts 2:38–39. What was promised to everyone God has called? What posture allows this promise to be fulfilled?

6. None of us were alive when Jesus died and rose again, but we can experience and receive the fulfillment of Passover. What comparison can you make in regards to the Holy Spirit fulfilling Pentecost?

**Live**

1. What personal views are hindering you from experiencing the Holy Spirit fulfillment of Pentecost?
2. In Acts 19:1–2, Paul asks the question, “Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?” Have you experienced your own personal Pentecost?
3. What is the best posture you can make to be empowered by the Holy Spirit daily?

**Pray**

Pray that the Lord would show you any areas in your life that would hinder the Holy Spirit’s fullness in you. Keep a posture of repentance and faith as you live out your day with your best friend. Learn to wait on Him and hear His voice. Let His presence empower you for everything you do.
